

# Mighty Kids

## **COVID - 19 Policies and Procedures**



**June 23rd, 2020**

Our goal: Create a safe and healthy environment for staff and children by making the necessary adjustments to help limit the risk of exposure to COVID-19.

Parents are advised to heed the following:

- Adults in contact with children attending Mighty Kids or Mighty Kids summer camp need to be hypervigilant about monitoring their children for symptoms and arranging for testing if their children develop two or more of the following symptoms: fever or signs of fever, new cough or worsening chronic cough, runny nose, headache, sore throat, new onset of fatigue, new onset of muscle pain, diarrhea or loss of taste or smell.
- If children attending Mighty Kids or Mighty Kids summer camp have a vulnerable adult at home, the parent will want to consider the risk of the child bringing COVID-19 home and exposing the vulnerable adult in the home.

## Mighty Kids COVID-19 Operational Plan

Drop-Off & Pick-Up: It is encouraged that one one adult per family be responsible for drop-off and pick -up of child(ren). Adults must stay outside unless absolutely necessary.

Upon arrival, parents will be asked to complete the COVID-19 screening questions. The child(ren)'s temperature will be taken and recorded.

The child's hands will be sanitized by a leader. They will then be permitted to enter the facility.

For pick-up, the parent will wait outside the door and the child(ren) will be brought to their parents.

Please note, unauthorized adults will not be permitted into the Mighty Kids facility. If you are needed by your child, a leader will bring your child to you.

Physical Distancing: In groups of children of 15 or less, physical distancing is not required between children. That being said, during Mighty Kids, children will not be permitted to hug, kiss, wrestle, or do any high contact activities.

Physical distancing will be encouraged, chairs will be 6 feet apart and leaders will adhere to physical distancing whenever possible. Social distancing will be encouraged, but not guaranteed.

Cleaning and Disinfection Procedures: Before and after it's use, the Mighty Kids facilities will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized using a solution that is registered in Canada with a Drug Identification Number and is labeled as a broad spectrum virucide.

Hand washing will be mandatory for all children throughout their time at Mighty Kids.

Health Canada approved hand sanitizers with at least a 70% alcohol content will be available to the children throughout their time at Mighty Kids.

There will be a washroom available exclusively to children and will be sanitized between each use.

No food will be served during their time at Mighty Kids. If your child requires snack for health reasons (diabetes, etc...) please provide a pre-packaged snack to send with your child.

We will not be putting out a water station for the children, children are welcome to bring their own water bottles. Water is available to the children in case of emergency.

## Nursery Specific Items:

The nursery will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized with the above mentioned solution.

The amount of toys will be minimized, and we will provide a “dirty toy bucket” for the children to put used toys in to be sanitized before another use.

We ask that children not bring snacks unless needed for health reasons (diabetes, etc...) Snack sharing between children is not permitted.

Social distancing is not required in groups of children that are 15 or less. Social distancing will be encouraged, but not guaranteed.

Sanitizer will be provided to sanitize change table.

Napping area will be kept clean and sanitary. Playpens will be sanitized between uses.

Nursery aged children (0-4 yrs) will have their own bathroom reserved specifically for their use.

Nursery aged children and Elementary aged children will have no contact for the duration of the program. Unauthorized adults will not be permitted into the nursery, if you are needed by your child, a leader will bring your child to you.

We are taking every precaution to ensure you children's safety. We are adhering or going above and beyond the government's requirements.
